School Policies 2023-2024

- Evaluation for student placement is free, however, once a level is determined the registration fee and hourly rates apply. Tuition payment/registration fee is required in full at time of registration to ensure placement in a class.
- End of Year Performance: Participation in the end of year performance is optional. If a student does not participate in this performance, he/she will continue to be included and learn the choreography for the performance piece during class time. Before planning to participate, please be aware Term V tuition must be paid in full to participate and to receive costumes, even if the student will not continue at QBS after the performance date. During Term V, some of the regularly scheduled class times will be used to rehearse the individual class performance pieces. For those participating, there will be a charge for costumes which will be due with the Term II tuition (October 9, 2023*). The price for costumes is as follows Creative Movement, Mini-Jazz, Mini Hip Hop, Pre-Ballet, Pre-Jazz, Pre-Hip Hop: \$60 per costume. All other classes (Ballet, Jazz, Hip Hop, Contemporary, Character): \$75 per costume. *An additional fee will be charged if payment is not received by October 9, 2023.
- Tuition Policy/Late Fees: Tuition is considered late after the first week of each Term. A late fee of \$20 per child will be assessed the first week of the term and will increase by \$10 each week thereafter. If payment is not received after the second week of the term, the student will not be allowed to participate in class until payment is received. It is the parent's responsibility to check the due dates for each Term. These dates are listed below and may also be found at www.queneditdance.com under Classes>Policies & Calendar. Tuition is non-refundable and may not be transferred or extended towards future tuition or to another person. No tuition credits are given for missed classes unless class is cancelled by the studio.
- **Missed classes** may be made up <u>within</u> the Term they are missed. If there is not a class available which is the same level as the class missed, the make up class must in a lower level class.
- An annual registration fee of \$30.00 for each student is due with the first term a student enrolls and is effective only for terms taken consecutively. A re-enrollment fee will be charged for any student who wishes to return after taking time off during the year.
- Cash or check will be accepted at the studio. A NSF fee of \$25 will be charged for any returned checks. Payments by credit card may be made through the following link: https://paynow.io/qbs As information, the PayNow payment method does add a 3.5% gateway fee, but this fee can be avoided if tuition is paid by cash or check.
- Family rates are available to families with more than one child enrolled in classes. The student in the highest level or taking the most hours will pay full tuition. Each additional child will receive a 10% discount on tuition.
- Withdrawal Policy: For the development of the dancers, we strongly encourage each dancer to complete a full year program. Fourteen (14) days written notice is required to discontinue any class. Because class sizes are limited for learning purposes, we will strictly adhere to the withdrawal policy. If any tuition is due at the time of withdrawal, parents/guardians will be responsible for all tuition payments due up to the point in which QBS has received written notification of the student's withdrawal. If a student has started a Term and decides to withdraw before any payments have been made, tuition is due in full for the class or classes that have been taken. Any tuition already paid before student withdrawal is non-refundable and non-transferrable.

Class Attire - Please label all shoes, tights & leotards with child's name

- Creative Movement & Pre-Ballet: Pink leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes
- Ballet Levels Beginner, 1 & 1A: Black leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes
- Ballet Levels 2 & up: Black leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes with ribbons
- Jazz: Black leotard, pink tights, black jazz shorts/pants; tan jazz shoes
- Contemporary: Black leotard, pink tights, black jazz shorts/pants, half shoes
- **Hip Hop:** Comfortable pants and t-shirt, black hip hop shoes (dance sneakers)
- Character: Black leotard, pink tights, black character shoes, black skirt (female)
- Hair: Ballet dancers should wear hair in a bun and pulled back away from face (including bangs). Other dancers should have hair pulled back from face in a ponytail if possible.
- Male Student Attire:
- Ballet: Black tights, white t-shirt, white socks, white ballet shoes; Jazz & Contemporary: same as ballet with half shoes
